Hi all

As mentioned above, the Nominating Committee has done a great job of locating 4 New Officers to help run your club for the 2024-2025 fiscal year. The committee did a great job in getting volunteers, a task that is sometimes very difficult. A big thanks for the 4 new members that stepped up and the 5 officers that will be continuing next fiscal year. Your club can't continue without these volunteers.

The Trips Schedule is also listed on the Home Page of the Website. When additional information about the trips is available it will be posted there. Pricing is not available at this time but will be available before the trip presentation meeting in July.

As mentioned above, the TSC Trip Selection Meeting (Bidfest) will be held in Houston on August 2 - 4, 2024. This is also posted on the Website Home Page and includes a link to reserve hotel rooms for the event. The event will be held at the Sheraton Houston Brookhollow Hotel (Galleria Area). The TSC rate is \$119 per night, per room plus taxes, etc. If you have never attended, it is a fun event and a chance to meet other TSC club members. Attendees will also see the proposed 2026 TSC trips and participate in the club voting process for the TSC vote. Once the TSC Meeting Registration link is active on their website we will add it to our Home Page. TSC

2024 EPIC Season passes are now on sale and available from our tour operator Sports America, at the following <u>LINK</u>. For those buying a pass through Sports America, they again will be offering a 6.5% credit toward your 2024-2025 trip. Current and Past EPIC Pass Holders will likely receive emails directly from Vail resorts suggesting that you renew your pass through them. IF YOU RENEW THROUGH VAIL YOU WILL NOT QUALIFY FOR THE 6.5% TRIP CREDIT. Again this year, Telluride is the only EPIC pass resort that only accepts a Full EPIC Pass.

For those that qualify for Military and First Responder EPIC Pass Discounts, these passes are not sold through Sports America and therefore you will need to get these directly through Vail.

2024 IKON Season Passes went on sale on **March 14th** and are available from our tour operator: Sports America at the following <u>LINK</u>. For those buying a pass through Sports America, they again will be offering a 6.5% credit toward your 2024-2025 trip. Current and Past IKON Pass Holders will likely receive emails directly from IKON suggesting that you renew your pass through them. IF YOU RENEW THROUGH IKON YOU WILL NOT QUALIFY FOR THE 6.5% TRIP CREDIT. For a limited time, they will also be able to offer Tour Operator early season group pricing on the IKON passes.

Please read the limitations of the three different IKON passes, more than a few resorts only accept the Full IKON Pass or Base Plus IKON Pass. These details are spelled out in the Sports America order form for each of the pass types. The IKON Base Plus Pass offers only a very small discount verses the Full IKON pass and rarely justifies the significant limitations of the Base Plus Pass verses the Full IKON Pass.

Please remember, these passes are not refundable or transferable, make sure you are sure you will use it before purchasing.
